The church is going good. We are waiting for your visit. Do you have a date yet for your coming to Port-de-Paix? Who is coming and how many people? Is there people from East Main street Church coming? Say Hi to Charlie, his daughter and his wife and the Ramsos and all the young men who came already. I miss you all.

I wish to come to Michigan with my wife to visit more places a time without snow. Lake Michigan is wonderful to me. Snow was amazing because saw it for the first time. I appreciated all the meetings and the people was very kind. The way that the ladies served the food was interesting. I told my wife we about Charlie's restaurant and the barbeque sandwiches.

I'm not dreaming but I want to let you know that I enjoyed my trip and thank you for allowing me to do that long travel. Why I need support for: evangelizm campaign during the year, radio broadcasts, Bible training classes and seminars. Sponsors are needed also for my orphanage and my school. This year we get to 8th grade. We add one class every year until 12 grade, and our plan is to have a trade school because hand works ae necessary for somebody to live where there is no job for educated people. If we can pay a teacher \$100/month, we'll solve the education problem of several hundreds of poor children.

Food, health and education are 3 main elements of my "New Hope ministries. So, any help is welcome.
